Bible Text: Exodus 3:13-15, Revelation 1:8

Reflection:

When Moses asked God's name, God declared, "I AM WHO I AM"—the eternal, self-existent One who depends on no one and never changes. In Revelation, Jesus proclaims that He is "The Alpha and the Omega," the beginning and the end, the One who is, who was, and who is to come. From Genesis to Revelation, Scripture reveals one unchanging God who remains faithful forever. Because God is eternal and unchanging, His promises are certain. He was faithful before we were born, He is faithful today, and He will remain faithful long after we are gone. As CBCM celebrates fifty years of ministry, we rejoice that the same God who called this church into existence continues to reign and will faithfully accomplish His purposes for generations to come.

1. How does knowing that God is the eternal "I AM" give you confidence when facing uncertainty about the future?
2. As CBCM moves into its next chapter of ministry, how can we demonstrate that our confidence is rooted in the eternal God rather than in changing circumstances?
