Bible Text: 1Peter 2:4-10

Reflection:

The Apostle Peter reminds believers that we are God's chosen people, a royal priesthood, and a holy nation—not for our own privilege, but "that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light." Our identity leads directly to our mission. God has graciously called us to Himself so that others may come to know Him as well. As CBCM celebrates God's faithfulness, we remember that we have been blessed in order to be a blessing to others.

1. How can you more intentionally proclaim God's goodness through your daily life?
2. As God's people, how can CBCM better reflect His character and make Christ known to our community and the nations?
