Bible Text: John 13:34-35

Reflection:

Jesus gave His disciples a new commandment: "Love one another as I have loved you." Our love for one another is one of the most powerful testimonies to the truth of the gospel. Before the world hears our message, it often sees our relationships. As CBCM moves "Mission Forward," our witness will be most compelling when our love reflects the sacrificial love of Christ.
